



Northern Lights School Division Scholarship/ Awards Program

(Approved April 2008 by the NLSD #113 Board of Education, revised Nov. 2008)

Current grade 12 graduates are eligible for a NLSD Scholarship or NLSD Award	NLSD #113 Students who have exited in the past from (grade 10, 11,12) and are now attending post secondary programs or are involved in an apprenticeship program are eligible for an NLSD Award

All Scholarships and Awards are selected by the NLSD #113 Scholarship Committee Selection will be finalized by the Committee by end of November of each year (the selected recipients are final).

NLSD #113 SCHOLARSHIPS ten \$2000.00 scholarships available

All students graduating in the current year (from regular, modified or alternate programs) who are registered in any post secondary educational program (including apprenticeship programs) are nominated by the school.

The school will follow the Nomination Process - *Spring process and fall process* – with the finalized, fully completed, nomination package for each student to be submitted by September 21st to the Career/ Transition Program Consultant, Central Office.

Ten recipients are selected based on highest academic standing. *(When possible at least one from each NLSD High School)*

NLSD #113 AWARDS twenty \$1000.00 awards are available each year

All nominations not selected for a NLSD Scholarship are automatically eligible for a NLSD Awards.

All past NLSD #113 students who have exited from a NLSD #113 high school (whether it was an early exit or exiting as a grade 12 graduate in past years) and are presently registered and regularly attending a post secondary program are eligible to forward their NLSD Awards Application Package (with application form included also) before September 21 of each year to:

NLSD Award recipients will be prioritized according to those who have not received a NLSD Scholarship or Award in the past.
